Physical Description:

This small collection is made up of three ledgers, dated 1883-1909, which appear to be the cash accounts of the station master or agent for the Kennebunk Beach railroad station. The number of passengers, trunks, kinds of supplies transported (by wagon ?) by the station master are listed under the names of individual cottage owners, hotels, etc. It is possible that these ledgers were acquired by the Museum with the diaries of Owen Wentworth for Freeman Wentworth was Station Master of a time. They do not have an accession number.
