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Physical Description:

This collection of records of the Kennebunk Public Health Association of Kennebunk, Maine from 1917-67, is comprised of secretarial and financial records in ledgers and looseleaf notebooks, typewritten histories, newspaper clippings, and other relevant materials.

It covers the early history of the organization when it was sponsored by the Board of Managers of the Webhannet Club as the "District Nursing Association" through its re-naming in 1920 as the "Kennebunk Public Health Association."

It is stored in one and a half boxes.

Most of the collection is part of Acq. #70:52-62.
