Physical Description:

The Wallingford Collection consists of one box of papers and account books, divided into seven folders, dating from 1731/3201842. Included are the papers of George W. Wallingford, 1776-1824, and related family members, including accounts relating to the guardianship of his children after Wallingford's death. See the folder breakdown for particulars.

The papers are in good condition. They have different accession numbers, as indicated in the folder breakdown.
