Physical Description:

This small collection of ledgers was placed in the care of the Brick Store Museum by the present board of the Hope Cemetery Corporation of Kennebunk. It is mainly a collection of out-of-date Treasurer's records, but does include a photocopy of a record book of burials in the cemetery from 1758 – 1881. That original record has been retained by the Corporation for reference.

The collection includes one half box which holds a few loose papers and two fragile ledgers. The collection's accession number is 87.41.1-8.

Box and Folder Breakdown:

- Folder 1: Papers removed from the Treasurer's Book, 1910 – 1978
- Folder 2: Papers removed from the Investment Ledger, 1888 – 1977
