Lois E. Waterhouse and Edna C. Harmon Collection

This is a collection given by two sisters of archival items relating to Lois E. Waterhouse (Kinney) and Edna C. Harmon of Kennebunk.

Lois Waterhouse Kinney, daughter of Homer T. and Bessie M. (Harmon) Waterhouse, was born on July 10, 1912, and died on January 17, 2007. Lois graduated as class valedictorian from Kennebunk High School in 1930, and from Mount Holyoke College in 1934.

Edna Harmon was born in 1880 and died in 1972. She graduated from Thornton Academy, Class of 1898. Edna was the sister of Bessie Waterhouse; therefore Edna Harmon was the aunt of Lois Waterhouse. Among her many activities Edna was the Head Librarian for Kennebunk from 1953 to 1959.
