

This collection was donated to the Museum by Kathy Ostrander-Roberts in 2012. She was the Assistant Archivist at The Brick Store Museum from 2003 to 2006, and Town Historian from 2008 to 2010. The collection consists of deeds and papers, photographs, and negatives that she accumulated over the course of twenty-plus years in her interest about local history.

The Collection is housed in 6 1/2 documents boxes, three document boxes of photographs, one document box and one notebook of negatives, one notebook of Kathy's *Pages From History*, (2012.154.100.370) one notebook entitled "A Collection of States and Town Cemetery Information, Maps and Records," (2012.154.001.371) two spiral bound lists of Kathy's inventory of the Collection, one box of CDs of local scenes, two boxes of interviews on tape with local people, a slide of a connected farmhouse, and one large box of newspapers and miscellaneous items. Kathy is also the author of *Kennebunk* and *Remembering the Kennebunk's*, two books on local history.

The Collection also consists of a KHS Girls Varsity Letter from 2005, antique Maine license plates from 1923, 1934 and 1935, and two wooden treenails, all of which are housed in the collections. The Collection has been given the number 2012.154.001 - .

The Collection has been accessioned by Terry Vaughn, Volunteer Archivist, and the Collection will put on Past Perfect in the near future.
