Booking & Payment Policies:

- You can pay in advance of your arrival or at the time of your visit. Credit card (Visa, Mastercard, or Discover), check, or cash is accepted.
- If you need an invoice for the tour, please request one at the time of your booking.
- It is preferred that one person pay for the entire group upon arrival (or beforehand). Collecting payment from individual group members delays your entrance into the Museum.

If your group must cancel, please notify the Brick Store Museum a minimum of 24 hours prior to your arrival.

Group Admission Rates

Adult & Senior Groups:

- Self-guided: \$5 p/p
- Guided: \$6 p/p
- Behind-the-scenes tours: \$10 p/p
- Historic District Walking Tours: \$8 p/p

Nonprofit/Educational:

- Self-guided: \$3.50 per adult, \$1.00 per child
- Guided visits: \$4.00 per adult, \$2.00 per child

RSU 21 and Surrounding Schools:

- Free!

Complimentary Group Admission:

Tour driver, group escort, caregivers (for children's & handicapped groups) receive complimentary admission.

Guided tours: an introduction to the Museum by a staff member; docent-led tour of galleries and time for Q&A.

Behind-the-scenes tours include the above and a staff-guided tour of the Museum's collections storage.

About Group Tours

Consider booking a Group Tour if your group has six or more people. The Museum is wheelchair accessible on the first floor galleries. There are two small second-floor galleries that cannot yet be accessed by wheelchair.

Scavenger hunts are available for self-guided groups with advance notice. When reserving your group visit, please let the Museum staff know of your interest in the Scavenger Hunt opportunity so we can have the correct amount ready for your group.

If you are interested in walking to lunch from the Museum in the downtown area, make sure to look for restaurants along Main Street - and make a day of it!

Parking

Will you be arriving in a motor coach, bus, or van? Are your group members driving themselves? Parking is available in the municipal parking lot to the left of the Museum; on the street in front of the Museum, and along Main Street. Larger parking areas are available just off of Main Street, on both Bourne Lane and Garden Street (there will be a short walk from these parking lots). Motor coaches and vans may drop off and pick up your group at the Museum's front entrance.
