Museum Pass Program for Libraries



The Brick Store Museum's Pass Program is offered FREE to public libraries in Maine and greater New England.

Terms of Pass: One pass allows free admission to the Museum for up to five people, twice per day. This does *not* include admission to special programs or events.

Enrollment: Libraries can request a digital pass from the Museum that can be printed by the Library when pass is requested. The pass is good for one year from date of enrollment. When this period ends, please contact us to renew your pass.

Publicity: Participating libraries are asked to communicate the availability of the Brick Store Museum Pass to their patrons through promotional avenues (website, newsletters, signage, etc.) where appropriate and available.

About the Museum: The Brick Store Museum, located at 117 Main Street in Kennebunk, is a local and regional history, art and culture museum founded in 1936 by American artist Edith Cleaves Barry. The Museum offers a variety of changing exhibits (4-5 exhibitions per year), an interactive family learning space, a seasonal Victory Garden, special programming and events, and a contemporary art gallery featuring local artists.
